

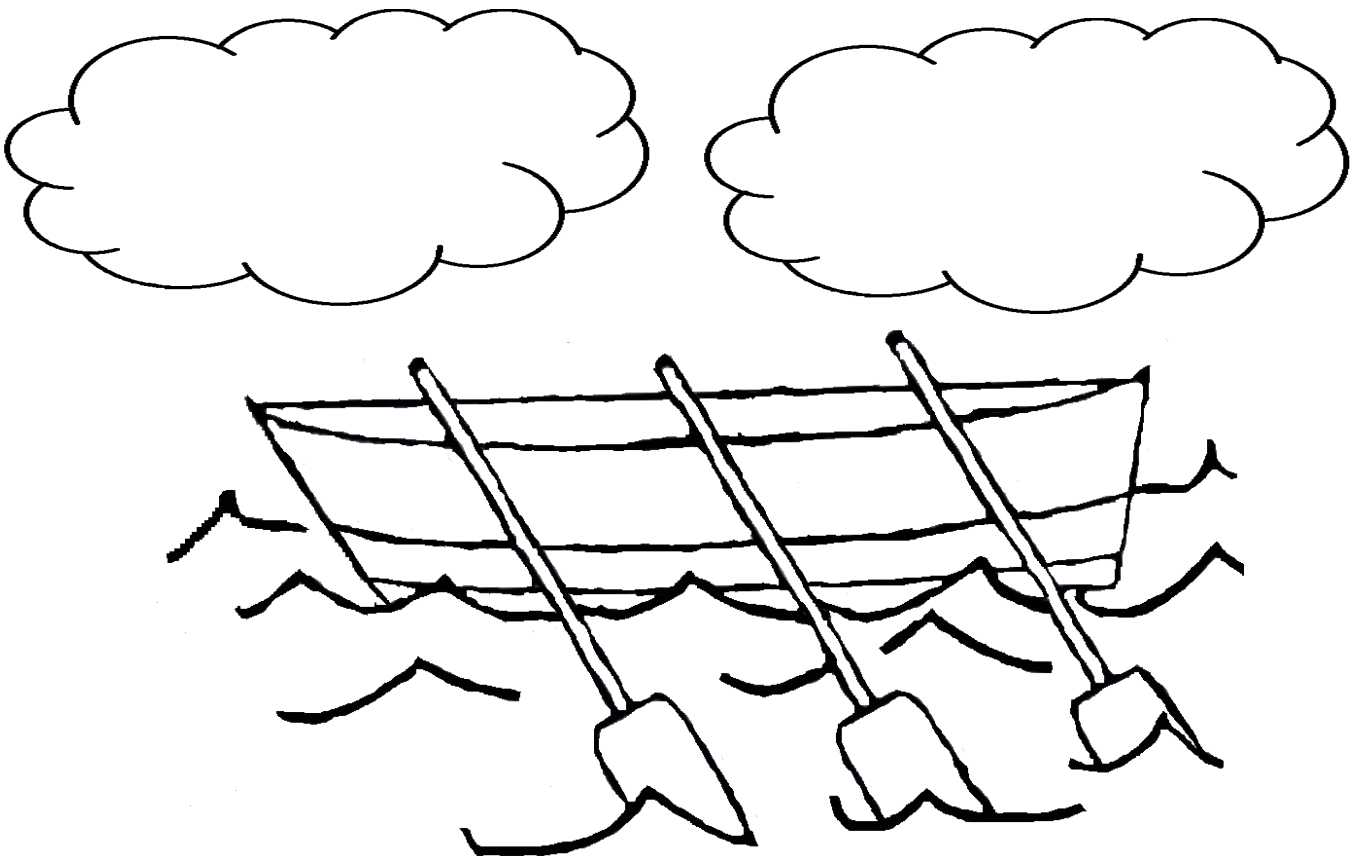


Peace Sunday 2021
